Browsing documents from your search results is a simple process. First click the document you want to access, this is the document details page, here you can see instances of your search terms within the document at a top level. The thumbnail viewer also allows you to quickly scroll through the full document.

The document details page also shows you all the metadata for the document you've just clicked into, metadata is basic information for a document including collection reference, title author, date and also places, names and topics that appear within the document itself.

On our newer resources you can click through the subject field to search the document for instances of these subjects.
